A group of concerned community members in Njeru started St. Francis in 1998 to fight the spread of HIV and to reduce the impact of AIDS. Since then, we have expanded to offer a wide variety of health services to *all people* in our community.

We aim to help you live a life of hope and dignity.

St. Francis has grown to a staff of 54 who care for over 10,000 clients with a wide range of health concerns. Our staff is trustworthy and friendly. We use our impressive facilities and staff for several programs that serve everyone from children to the elderly.

As part of our **Core Values**, we believe that all human beings are equal. Everyone has a right to access health information and services.

Our Services

We provide medical care both in our facilities and in the community.

In Our Facilities

Our team is able to identify and respond to several health problems. We can perform tests, diagnose illnesses, and provide treatment for a variety of conditions, including the following:

In the Community

We provide Home-Based Care for those who cannot transport to our facilities. Our doctors visit many clients at their homes. They also visit community drug distribution points organized by volunteers. Call St. Francis to find out about volunteers near you.

Counseling and Testing

Our team of counselors and doctors routinely visits villages to conduct HIV testing. Our counselors provide advice on how to live a healthy life.

Our Community

We help our community by using a holistic approach.

In Village Savings & Loans Associations, we educate our groups to start saving money for future emergencies and investments. All people

- young and old, HIV positive and negative - are welcome to get involved. Our hope is that each group develops an income-generating activity (IGA) such as farming or brickmaking to boost their household income.



St. Francis Njeru has two Saturday programs where youth participate in sports, music, dance, drama, and more. Youth receive counseling, medical checkups, and treatment free of charge. Our Shadow Idols are youth ages 10-18 who learn about life skills and reproductive health. They also



engage with professionals such as engineers, lawyers, and doctors. Our **Young Positives** are youth ages 10-21 who are learning how to live with HIV/AIDS while benefitting from the support of a loving and understanding community.

Omoana House is a temporary rehabilitation center at St. Francis Njeru for Stage 3 and 4 HIV Positive and malnourished youth ages 4-18. These children regain their physical health while receiving counseling and support.

We ask that clients for ART, child immunization, and natal services visit on Tuesdays and Thursdays.

Fees

St. Francis strives to be as affordable as possible for you!

Our **HIV Positive** clients pay only a 2,000 Ush user fee per visit. There are no additional costs for drugs.

Our **HIV Negative** clients pay only a 5,000 Ush consultation fee per visit plus the cost of any necessary tests or drugs.
